

County-Wide Messages

The following shall be the criteria for County-Wide messages to be transmitted by the Fire Communications Center (FireCom). All messages are to be approved by the Chief Fire Marshal. For further information or to arrange for a County-Wide Message as defined below, please call the On-Duty Supervisor at (516) 742-3191

1. Death of fire person killed in the line of duty (line of duty defined by Chief of Department).
2. Death of Ex-Chief, Ex-Commissioner or Honorary Chief.
3. Death of active Chief, Assistant Chief or Commissioner.
4. Death of an officer of a fire association of Nassau County, as follows:
 - a. Nassau County Firemen's Association
 - b. Fire Chiefs Council of Nassau County
 - c. South Shore Volunteer Fire Departments Association
 - d. North Shore Fire Council
 - e. Executive Council of Firemanic Associations of N.C.
 - f. Association of Fire Districts of Nassau County.
5. Death of an officer from Nassau County of the following:
 - a. F.A.S.N.Y.
 - b. Southern New York Volunteer Firemens' Association
 - c. New York Association of Fire Chiefs.
 - d. Association of Fire Districts of the State of N.Y.
6. Death of Past President of a Nassau County or New York State Firematic Association.
7. Death of a uniformed staff member of the Fire Marshal's Office.
8. Death of a uniformed member of the Fire Service Academy.
9. Events of interest to the Nassau County Fire Service (omit profit-making events).
 - a. F.C.C.N.C. Seminar.
 - b. County Memorial Service.
 - c. A sudden change of meeting location, sudden cancellation of meeting, (at the same time, the new location and date of meeting to be given), for only organizations that belong to the Executive Council of Firematic Associations.
 - d. Notice of change of classes of the Fire Service Academy.
10. Cancellations of Fire Service Academy or Fire Marshal's Office classes that are composed of all departments.

THE ABOVE ITEMS 1 THROUGH 10 MAY BE ANNOUNCED ONCE ON EACH OF TWO DATES AT 1842 HOURS.

11. Blood **URGENTLY** needed for fire or police personnel.
12. Severe weather "Alerts".
13. Special interest bulletins of emergency nature.

THE ABOVE ITEMS 11 THROUGH 13 MAY BE ANNOUNCED AS CIRCUMSTANCES WARRANT.
