

A LOCAL LAW TO AMEND A LOCAL LAW TO PROVIDE RELIEF FROM FEES
CHARGED BY THE VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS OF COUNTY GOVERNMENT TO THE
VICTIMS OF HURRICANE/SUPER STORM SANDY

Passed by the Nassau County Legislature on August 1, 2016

BE IT ENACTED by the County Legislature of the County of Nassau, that:

Section 1: TITLE 79 – FEE RELIEF FOR HURRICANE/SUPER STORM SANDY

VICTIMS of the Miscellaneous Laws of Nassau County is hereby renumbered as Title 79-a of
the Miscellaneous Laws of Nassau County.

Section 2: Subdivision (e) of Section 3 of TITLE 79-a – FEE RELIEF FOR
HURRICANE/SUPER STORM SANDY VICTIMS of the Miscellaneous Laws of Nassau
County, as renumbered, is amended as follows:

(e) No waiver or refund of fees pursuant to this section shall be granted after December
31, 2017.

Section 3:: It is hereby determined, pursuant to the provisions of the State Environmental
Quality Review Act, 8 N.Y.E.C.L. section 0101 et seq. and its implementing regulations, Part

617 of 6 N.Y.C.R.R., and Section 1611 of the County Government Law of Nassau County, that the adoption of this local law is a "Type II" Action within the meaning of Section 617.5(c)(20) of 6 N.Y.C.R.R. ("routine or continuing agency administration and management, not including new programs or major reordering of priorities that may affect the environment"), and, accordingly, is of a class of actions which do not have a significant effect on the environment; and no further review is required.

Section 4. Effective Date. This local law shall take effect immediately.
