LOCAL LAW 11 -2018

A LOCAL LAW TO AMEND THE NASSAU COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE TO ESTABLISH AN EMERGENCY AMBULANCE BUREAU

Passed by the Nassau County Legislature on June 18, 2018

Became a law on June 20,2018 with the approval of the Deputy County Executive acting on behalf of the County Executive.

WHEREAS, it is appropriate for this Legislature to formally establish an Emergency Ambulance Bureau within the Nassau County Police Department to promote the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County; now, therefore

BE IT ENACTED by the Nassau County Legislature as follows:

Section 1. A new section 8-6.2 is hereby added to Chapter VIII of the Administrative Code of Nassau County which shall read as follows:

§8-6.2 Emergency Ambulance Bureau.

There shall be a bureau to be known as the Emergency Ambulance Bureau. The Emergency Ambulance Bureau shall be responsible for the coordination, command, control and oversight of the emergency medical services operations, services and other support organizations to ensure the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County.

§2. Severability. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section, or part of this law or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder hereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section, or part of this law, or in its application to the person or circumstance directly involved in the controversy in which such order or judgment shall be rendered.

§3. It is hereby determined, pursuant to the provisions of the State Environmental Quality Review Act, 8 N.Y.E.C.L., section 0101 et seq. and its implementing regulations, Part 617 of 6 N.Y.C.R.R., and section 1611 of the County Government Law of Nassau County, that the adoption of this local law is a "Type II" Action within the meaning of Section 617.5(c)(20) and (27) of 6 N.Y.C.R.R., and, accordingly, is of a class of actions which do not have a significant effect on the environment; and no further review is required.

§4. This local law shall take effect immediately.
