

LOCAL LAW NO. 13 - 2008

A LOCAL LAW TO AMEND SUBDIVISION H OF SECTION 21-10.0 OF THE NASSAU COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE IN RELATION TO INCREASING THE FEE THAT MAY BE CHARGED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF CONSUMER AFFAIRS FOR ADVERTISEMENTS PLACED ON A WEB SITE MAINTAINED ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT.

BE IT ENACTED by the County Legislature of the County of Nassau as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision h of section 21-10.0 of the Nassau County Administrative Code, as last amended by Local Law No. 20-2002, is amended to read as follows:

h. To undertake activities to encourage local business and industry to maintain high standards of honesty, fair business practices, and public responsibility in the production, promotion and sale of consumer goods and services, and to permit licensees and others in good standing with the Department of Consumer Affairs to place advertisements on a web site maintained on behalf of the Department and to make rules and charge fees for such advertisements not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500) per advertisement per year.

§ 2. This Local Law shall take effect immediately.

PROPOSED LOCAL LAW NO. - 2008

A LOCAL LAW TO AMEND SUBDIVISION H OF SECTION 21-10.0 OF THE NASSAU COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE IN RELATION TO INCREASING THE FEE THAT MAY BE CHARGED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF CONSUMER AFFAIRS FOR ADVERTISEMENTS PLACED ON A WEB SITE MAINTAINED ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT.

BE IT ENACTED by the County Legislature of the County of Nassau as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision h of section 21-10.0 of the Nassau County Administrative Code, as last amended by Local Law No. 20-2002, is amended to read as follows:

h. To undertake activities to encourage local business and industry to maintain high standards of honesty, fair business practices, and public responsibility in the production, promotion and sale of consumer goods and services, and to permit licensees and others in good standing with the Department of Consumer Affairs to place advertisements on [the] a web site maintained [by] on behalf of the Department [of Consumer Affairs] and to make rules and charge fees for such advertisements not to exceed [one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00)] five hundred dollars (\$500) per advertisement per year.

§ 2. This Local Law shall take effect immediately.
