LOCAL LAW NO. 1-2011

A LOCAL LAW TO AMEND THE COUNTY GOVERNMENT LAW OF NASSAU
COUNTY IN RELATION TO THE ALLOCATION OF FUNDS FOR THE NASSAU
COUNTY LEGISLATURE

Passed by the Nassau County Legislature on February 28, 2011

Became a law on March 8, 2011 with the approval of the County Executive.

BE IT ENACTED by the County Legislature of the County of Nassau, as follows:

Section 1. Article I of the County Government Law of Nassau County is amended to add the following section:

§115. There shall be separate control centers in the Annual Budget and Budget Ordinance for the Majority, Minority, the Office of the Clerk of the Legislature and Office of Legislative Budget Review. The funds appropriated for the County Legislature in the Annual Budget, exclusive of the funds for the Office of the Clerk of the County Legislature and the Office of Legislative Budget Review, shall be allocated to the Majority and Minority in the proportion that the Majority members of the Legislature will bear to nineteen (19) and the proportion that the Minority members of the Legislature will bear to nineteen (19) as of the commencement of the fiscal year for which the budget is adopted. The County Legislature shall adopt an ordinance or resolution to effect the allocation in December of each year where necessary. Notwithstanding anything else to the contrary, this section may only be altered, amended, repealed or superseded by thirteen affirmative votes of the County Legislature.

Section 2. Effective Date: This law shall take effect immediately after becoming a law.
