LOCAL LAW NO. 1 - 2014

A LOCAL LAW TO AMEND THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE IN RELATION TO DESIGNATING THE PROPER PARTIES TO RECEIVE SERVICE OF PROCESS IN ACTIONS AND LEGAL PROCEEDINGS AGAINST THE COUNTY

BE IT ENACTED by the County Legislature of the County of Nassau as follows:

Section 1. Section 11-4.0 of the Nassau County Administrative Code, as amended by Local Law No. 8-1991, is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 11-4.0 **Actions and proceedings.** All process and papers for the commencement of actions and legal proceedings against the County of Nassau or any agency, commission, department or bureau thereof, shall be served in accordance with the New York Civil Practice Law and Rules, and all actions or proceedings, wherein the County of Nassau or any agency, commission, department or bureau thereof is a party shall be brought and maintained in the County of Nassau.


Section 2. Severability. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section, or part of this law or the application thereof to any person, individual, corporation, firm, partnership, entity, or circumstance shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder

thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section or part of this law, or in its application to the person, individual, corporation, firm, partnership, entity, or circumstance directly involved in the controversy in which such order or judgment shall be rendered.

Section 3. It is hereby determined, pursuant to the provisions of the State Environmental Quality Review Act, 8 N.Y.E.C.L. section 0101 et seq. and its implementing regulations, Part 617 of 6 N.Y.C.R.R., and Section 1611 of the County Government Law of Nassau County, that the adoption of this local law is a "Type II" Action within the meaning of Section 617.5(c)(20) and (27) of 6 N.Y.C.R.R., and, accordingly, is of a class of actions which do not have a significant effect on the environment; and no further review is required.

Section 4. This local law shall take effect immediately.
