A LOCAL LAW in relation to increasing the amount of a revolving fund for the Nassau County Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-housing Program established pursuant to Local Law 19-2009

BE IT ENACTED by the Nassau County Legislature as follows:

Section 1. Section 2 of Local Law 19-2009 is amended to read as follows:


§ 2. Notwithstanding section 403 of the Nassau County Charter, the County Treasurer is authorized and directed to furnish the Office of Housing and Homeless Services with the sum of [one hundred thousand (\$ 100,000.00)] two hundred fifty thousand (\$250,000) dollars from funds heretofore appropriated for such department, for the establishment of a revolving fund checking account for the disbursement of monies received from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development as part of the Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program under Title XII of the

American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (Pub. L. 111-5).

§ 2. This Legislature finds and determines that pursuant to the provisions of the State Environmental Quality Review Act, 8 N.Y.E.C.L. section 0101 et seq. and its implementing regulations, Part 617 of 6 N.Y.C.R.R., and Section 1611 of the County Government Law of Nassau County, that action related to this local law is a "Type II" Action within the meaning of Section 617.5(c)(20), and, accordingly, is of a class of actions which do not have a significant effect on the environment; and no further review is required.

§ 3. This local law shall be effective immediately.
