If you are requesting an upgrade to your Nassau County Home Improvement License, the following information is required:

- 1. A signed letter by owner requesting the specific type of work. Please note that the words "home remodeling", "home improvement", "general contracting", "new construction", or "renovations" will NOT be accepted. The categories of work performed must be specific. Fill out attached Work Being Performed (Circle) Sheet.
- 2. Five years recent relevant and verifiable experience. (ex. W2 or 1099 forms that show type of work or a home improvement license elsewhere for the additional work or one contract & notarized consumer letter from each of the last five years.)
- 3. A current Certificate of Business Liability Insurance with the description of work that you are licensed to perform. If you are hiring sub-contractors, you must have "sub-contracting" listed on your policy. Certificates that expire within 30 days are not acceptable.
- 4. A current Certificate of Workman's Compensation Insurance on a U26 or 105.2 form; or if no employees, a current CE-200 form, (Waiver). Certificates that expire within 30 days are not acceptable.
- 5. A current RRP Lead certification in an owner's name, if required. See 40 CFR Part 745.225 and Rule 18 of the Rules and Regulations Relating to the Home Improvement Business.
- 6. A current business phone number and email address.
