Joe,

As per yesterday's Inspection with Otis Elevator, they inspected and tested to ensure that the hydraulic shaft and shaft seal was not compromised (leaking or burr's). The shaft, seal and the hydraulic recovery pump are mechanically in good operational condition.

After future investigation to figure out how the water was entering the shaft, the Otis supervisor was able to point out that the shaft is in a sleeve which allows water from the earth to enter and out of that shaft sleeve.


