New York State Department of Environmental Conservation Community Air Monitoring Meeting Notes and Correspondence

Meeting with NYSDEC Community Air Monitoring January 24, 2024

Attendees: Hugh Cirrito, NYSDEC Regional Engineer; Shaun Snee, NYSDEC Regional Air Pollution Control Engineer; Yin Zhao, NYSDEC Engineer; Terri Elkowitz, VHB

- Terri Elkowitz explained that VHB is Sands' SEQR consultant and status of SEQR review with
 Town. Discussed scoping meeting and briefly reviewed scope for air quality analysis. Indicated
 that we have reviewed the Community Air Monitoring presentations that the NYSDEC has made,
 including the most recent from September 2023
- Terri Elkowitz indicated that, based on those presentations, data was targeted to be available in early 2024
- Shaun Snee indicated that the raw data I held by a local license holder, and that Aclima is the consultant working on the air monitoring
- Terri Elkowitz advised that the Scope requires formal consultation with the NYSDEC to secure information regarding the status of and results of the community air monitoring initiative and that relevant information provided by the NYSDEC was to be included in the DEIS
- Terri Elkowitz discussed the analyses that are being performed, and that, based on the review of the NYSDEC presentations, Sands is already incorporating applicable measures that were identified and is undertaking an extensive traffic impact study and developing a mitigation program.

VHB is serving as the State Environmental Quality Review (SEQR) consultant for the proposed Sands Integrated Resort, at the Nassau Veterans Memorial Coliseum property in Uniondale, New York.

The scoping process for the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) is on-going, and with respect to air quality, among other things, we are required to consult with the NYSDEC "to secure information regarding the status of and results of the community air monitoring initiative" for the above-referenced disadvantaged community and include the information in the DEIS.
