 - a DVD of their **EXACT** performance (wearing exact attire/costume) being no more than three minutes in length. DVD's will NOT be returned.
 - Proof of Age (if under 18 years)
 - Proof of Nassau County Residency
 - One form of ID may satisfy all requirements, i.e. Driver's License. ID may be requested at Rehearsal.
- This is a non-competitive showcase for ages 6 years to adult for solo or duet talent.
- No commercial or business entities will be accepted.
- We reserve the right to disqualify any submission of inappropriate entertainment.
- 20 acts will be chosen for showcase.
- Talent submissions for solo or duet acts may include: Comedy, Dance, Vocal, Magic, Gymnastics, Instrumental Music and Novelty Acts.
- Nassau County will not be responsible for any play back failures in submission of DVDs or performance CDs.
- Applicants selected for the Showcase will receive confirmation via telephone and email. Should the applicant not respond within 48 hours, they will be ineligible for the Showcase.
- Applicants must be available for Dress Rehearsal at Lakeside Theatre on August 27th at 5pm.
- Applicants selected must bring duplicates of their performance CDs on Rehearsal Day.
